## The Legacy at Willow Bend hosts art party for Dallas Jewish Community Foundation donors

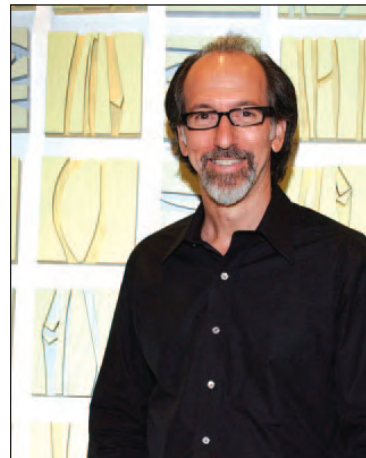
